

















## Yankton Buck Basketball 2017-2018

### 2017-2018 Season Highlights

Winning our season opener against a young and talented Huron team at the Huron Arena. Cameron led the Bucks with a career high 18 points on five made 3 pointers.

Defeated a very good Brandon Valley team in the *Sanford Pentagon Throwback Classic* game at the Sanford Pentagon in Sioux Falls by the score of 49-37. It was the only time all year that Brandon Valley was held in the 30's. The Bucks moved to 2-0.

Our first games after Christmas saw the Bucks playing in its first ever Mike Miller Classic. We defeated the Mitchell Kernels in the Corn Palace to move into the championship game of the Gary Munson Tournament. The next night we played DeLaSalle, a powerhouse out of Minnesota. DeLaSalle was the 6 time defending state AAA champions in Minnesota and went on to a record of 25-5 before losing in the state semifinals, ending their state championship run. The Bucks gave the Islanders all they wanted and had a chance to tie or win the game in the final seconds but it was not to be as the Bucks fell 57-61.

The Bucks picked up their first home win of the season on January 5<sup>th</sup> over the Watertown Arrows by the score of 70-48. Matthew had a great game with 37 points on six made 3 pointers. Casey, Rex and Owen all followed with 8 points.

The Bucks started a 4 game win streak at Sioux Falls O'Gorman by defeating the Knights 66-57. The Bucks showed great scoring balance in this game; led by Jack with 19 points, Matthew with 18, Cameron with 11, Rex with 9 and Casey with 7. A couple nights later the Bucks traveled to Brookings and jumped out to a big 27-0 lead before winning 66-38. After a couple nice road wins the Bucks welcomed in the Aberdeen Central Golden Eagles. The Bucks outscored Aberdeen 39-25 in the second half to win 61-46. Matthew set a school record for points in a game with 42! He scored 31 of those in the second half alone! Three nights later the Bucks welcomed in the number 1 ranked and undefeated Harrisburg Tigers. The Bucks were able to win a hard fought battle in front of a raucous home court crowd by the final of 50-48.

After dropping a home game to Huron, ending the Bucks 4 game winning streak, we took to the road to Pierre looking to start another win streak. Just outside of Tyndall our bus was hit by a giant snowball, coming off a semi-truck from ongoing traffic, smashing in the front window of the bus! Denny was the MVP of the day by keeping the bus steady and driving us to safety! After about an hour or so of cleaning up glass and loading another bus we set off for Pierre again. Matthew and Jack had great games scoring a combined 47 points and leading us to a 58-50 win, the first of three wins in a row. Next up we took to the road for another tough challenge at Sioux Falls Washington. In another great defensive effort, we were able to defeat the Warriors 50-39, the only time all year the Warriors scored in the 30's. We once again had three players in double figures as Matthew and Jack had 13 and Rex had 11. Later that week the Bucks jumped out to an early lead and never looked back in defeating the Mitchell Kernels by a final of 54-34. It was the 12<sup>th</sup> straight win for the Bucks over the Kernels.

We picked up another solid road ESD win at Watertown on February 17<sup>th</sup> by the final score of 54-50. Matthew and Rex lead us in scoring with 17 & 12 points. Casey and Cameron chipped in with 7 each.

A solid 4<sup>th</sup> quarter helped us defeat the Brookings Bobcats by a final score of 61-49. Matthew had another great game by scoring 38 points, 22 of them coming in the second half.

We finished the regular season with a 13-7 overall record; 11-5 in the ESD and 2-2 in non-conference games. 3 of our non-conference games were on the road against Sioux Falls schools. We went 2-1 against them. Our last non-conference game was at a neutral site against DeLaSalle.

### 2017-2018 Post Season Highlights

After falling to Brandon Valley in the regular season finale we dropped from the 6<sup>th</sup> overall seed all the way down to the 11<sup>th</sup> overall seed. In the new *Round of 16* that meant another road trip to preseason number 1 Aberdeen, not exactly a great draw. We split with Aberdeen during the regular season beating them at our place and losing to them just a couple weeks earlier in Aberdeen. The Golden Eagles were playing better than anyone in the state as their lost loss was to us on January 20<sup>th</sup>. Ben Jurrens helped us get off to a great start scoring 7 first quarter points as we raced out to a 16-9 first quarter lead. Aberdeen cut our lead down to 4 at half; 26-22. We had a nice 8-point lead near the end of the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter before Aberdeen banked in a 3 pointer at the buzzer, our lead was trimmed to 5; 36-31. After controlling most of the game we faltered a bit down the stretch at the free throw line and taking care of the ball. Give Aberdeen credit they made a huge shot with 20 seconds to go to tie the game. We held the ball for the last shot. Matthew kicked out to Cameron who hit a 28 footer and we win 47-44! A great dogpile and celebration afterwards as we were going to the state tournament!

To say we didn't get the best draw in the first round of the state tournament would once again be an understatement. Sioux Falls Lincoln was preseason number 2 and ranked number 1 for a big portion of the regular season. They came into the tournament as the number 3 overall seed. We jumped out to an early lead but Lincoln answered and took a 16-14 lead after one quarter of play. The second quarter was all Sioux Falls Lincoln as they outscored us 18-6 to take a 34-20 halftime lead. We regrouped at halftime and came out on a 9-0 run to get right back within 3. We outscored the Patriots 21-9 in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter and only trailed by 2 heading into the fourth quarter, thanks to a huge 3 at the buzzer from Casey that sent the old Arena into a frenzy! The rest of the game was a back and forth affair with both teams making play after play and shot after shot. Trailing by one with 18 seconds to go Jack stole the inbounds pass, flipped it to Matthew who raced down the floor made a layup and got fouled. After Matthew converted the free throw we lead by 2. Lincoln missed a 3-point attempt and a tough put back and we won the game 59-57! The first round curse was broken in dramatic fashion! Yankton was playing on Friday night for the first time since 1981! It felt really good to say "we will see you tomorrow night." The Yankton crowd that filled the Sioux Falls Arena was a major reason for us being able to pull off the victory.

In the semifinals we faced Rapid City Central. They had been rated in the top 5 for most of the season and came in as the number 2 overall seed. Again we had a nice start but Central answered by hitting two 3's to end the first quarter and we only found ourselves up 16-13 after the first quarter. The second quarter was back and forth. Jack hit a 3 at the buzzer to send us into halftime with a 31-28 advantage. We played great defense in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter holding the Cobblers to only 7 points. Continuing to play well we stretched out a lead in the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter only to see Central continuing to fight and hit some tough 3 pointers in the last couple minutes to make us earn the victory. Matthew went 11-11 from the free throw line in the fourth quarter to help seal the victory. He also finished the game with 38 points! The Bucks were in the state finals for the first time since 1981! Once again the Yankton faithful showed up to support their Bucks and helped us pull out another victory. Now onto Championship Saturday!

Our rival, the Harrisburg Tigers awaited us on Saturday night. Most considered them the best team in the state throughout the season. Big shot Cam got us off on the right foot by making two first quarter 3's and we lead 9-5 at quarters end. Our defense proved solid in the second quarter holding Harrisburg to only 7 points and 12 total for the first half. We lead 19-12 at the half. A nice start to the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter allowed us to build a 30-15 advantage. The Tigers would not go away easily and fought back to trail 30-23 after 3 quarters. The fourth quarter got extremely tight as Harrisburg cut our lead down to 2 on a couple different occasions but big baskets down the stretch by Rex and Matthew kept us in the lead. Up 2 with just over 2 seconds to play, we had to defend one last time. Harrisburg had the ball on their sideline out of bounds. We defended their play great and won the game by a final of 39-37! The Yankton Bucks were the state champions for the first time in 40 years! The first title since 1978! Our defense was the key! Harrisburg averaged over 65 points a game. The only time all year they scored in the 40's was when we beat them at our place 50-48. To hold them to 37 was a remarkable effort by the Yankton Bucks! There were over 7,500 people in attendance for the game. It seemed like almost all of them were wearing red and hailed from Yankton! Once again the fan support carried us to victory. How sweet it was to celebrate with our team, families, school and community in Sioux Falls!


