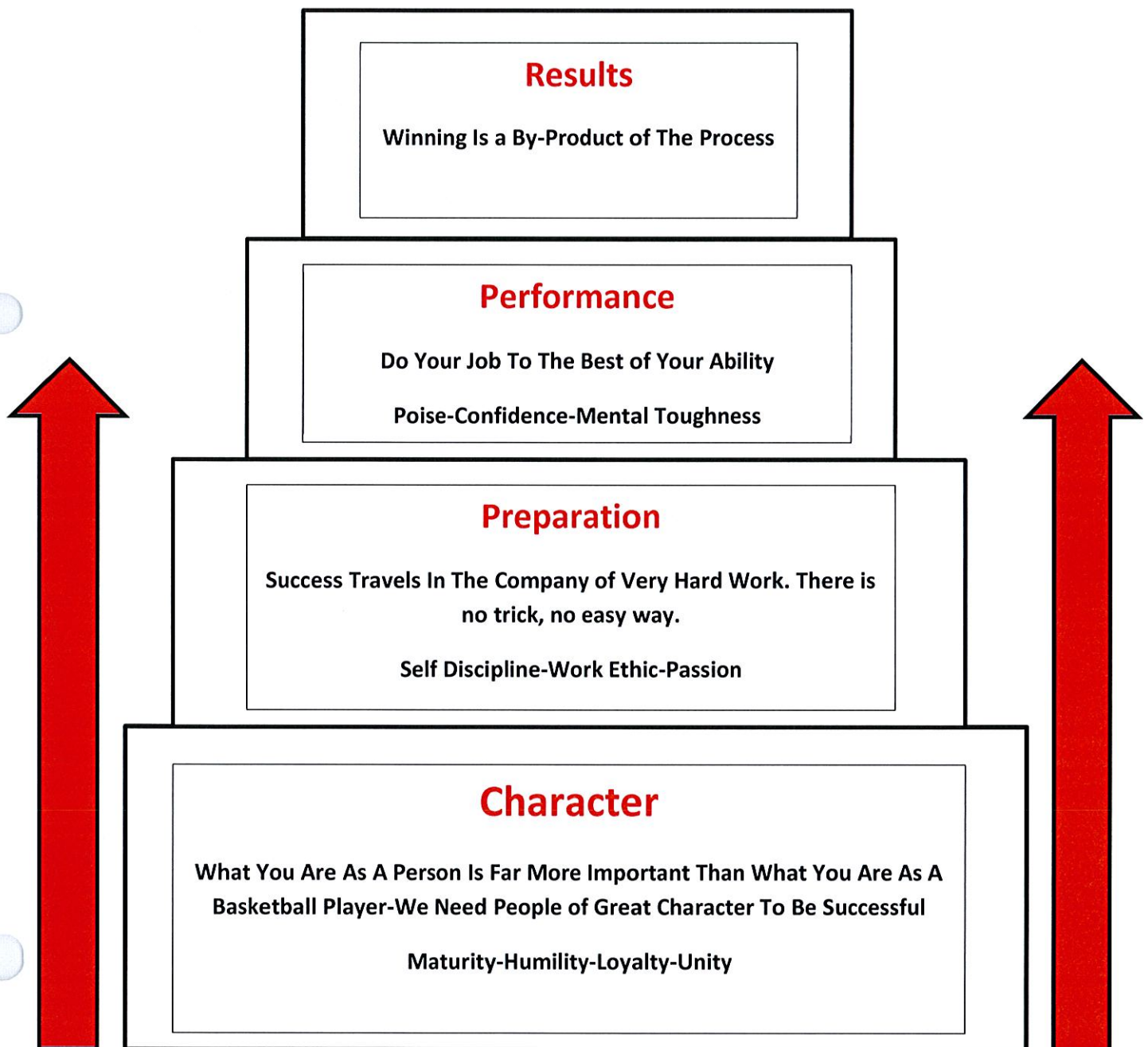

We are not going to talk about what we are going to accomplish, we are going to talk about how we are going to do it.

It is not the end result. Don't think about winning the ESD championship. Don't think about winning the state championship. Think about what you need to do in this drill, on this possession, in this moment. That is the process; let's think about what we can do today, the task at hand.



2016-2017 Season Highlights

Winning our home opener against a very skilled and talented Harrisburg team by the score of 58-51. We had a great crowd on hand and were able to make some big plays down the stretch to pull out the victory.

Falling to a very tough Sioux Falls Washington team at home by the final of 65-68. The Bucks were led by Matthew Mors' school record tying 41 points in the game. He tied Chad Nelson's record set way back in 1978.

Two nights after falling to the Washington Warriors the Bucks bounced back in tremendous fashion by defeating the Mitchell Kernels 60-37 in the Corn Palace. It marked the 5 straight victory for the Bucks in the Corn Palace. We headed into Christmas break with a 2-1 record.

The Bucks opened up play after Christmas break with a cold 1st half at Brandon Valley. However, the Bucks heated up scoring 38 second half points and had a ¾ court shot hit off the front of the rim, which would have won the game, but instead fell 46-48.

We started the 2017 year off on a great note by defeating a Pierre team that would go on to place 4th at the state tournament. The game was back and forth all night until the Bucks were able to pull ahead for good in the 4th quarter. The Bucks were a very impressive 19/22 from the free throw line in the game.

The night after defeating Pierre, the Bucks once again welcomed an ESD foe into Yankton. This time the Bucks would face a very talented and preseason ESD favorite in Aberdeen Central. The Bucks had a nice 2nd quarter and went into halftime leading the Golden Eagles by 6. The Bucks exploded offensively at the end of 3rd quarter and into the 4th quarter to take a 20 point lead on the team that would eventually play in the state title game. We were able to hold off the Golden Eagles by a final score of 58-47 capping off the best weekend of the season by sweeping Pierre and Aberdeen.

After a couple tough games, the Bucks went back on the road to face another team that would eventually play in the state tournament and finish 3rd in the ESD in the Huron Tigers. The Bucks got off to a hot start and never looked back outscoring the Tigers 44-24 through 3 quarters and a final 60-36. It was the 3rd win in five years for the Bucks at the Huron Arena.

A few nights after winning in Huron the Bucks took to the road again by traveling to Harrisburg. We were able to complete the season sweep of the Tigers by the final score of 63-53.

The Bucks won a third straight game, all on the road, at Sioux Falls Roosevelt to finish out a great month of January. The Bucks were down 16-4 after the first quarter but were able to close the gap to 23-21 by halftime. The second half was back and forth but we were able to make some great plays in the 4th quarter to pull out a 57-51 victory. It was the Bucks second straight win against the Rough Riders.

After a tough couple weeks in February, the Bucks were able to close out the regular season by defeating the Mitchell Kernels 66-40 at home on "Senior Night." It was a great way to send out our 3 seniors; Nate, Justin and AJ.

We ended our season in the District "Play-In" game at Harrisburg against the Tigers. We got off to a great start and lead by ten after the 1st quarter, five at halftime and nine at the end of the 3rd quarter. Unfortunately, the Tigers were able to make a few more plays in the 4th quarter and we fell 54-58.

We would have loved to have won more games and made the state tournament, however we are extremely proud of the things that we did accomplish. We do not measure success on wins and losses and feel that our players and team were very successful on a number of different levels this season.
